Honey Bee Bookmark

Recipe

Sets: Backyard Basics #129258 (c) #129255 (w); Six Sided Sampler #130956 (c) 130953 (w);

Card Stock: Naturals White #102314; Crushed Curry #131199; Chocolate Chip #102128;

Ink: Black StazOn #101406, Soft Suede #126978;

Markers: Crushed Curry (in the Regals Set #131262) Basic Black #100082;

Big Shot: Backyard Basics Framelits #129372, Hexagon Hive #132965;

Punches: Scalloped Tag Topper Punch #133324;

Accessories: Natural Trim Burlap # 129287; 2-way Glue Pen #100425; Dazzling

Diamonds Glitter #102023; Early Espresso Baker's Twine #123124;

Non Stampin' Up! materials: Waxed Paper

Instructions

1. Cut out two Hexagon Hive pieces: One out of Naturals White and one out of Crushed Curry.
2. Use the Scallop Punch at one end of a 5 1/2"x 2" Naturals bookmark and a 5 7/8"x 2" Chocolate Chip bookmark.
2. Place the naturals hive over the bookmark at an angle. Hold it in place while you trim off the excess.
3. Sponge the edges of the "hive" and the edges of the Crushed Curry hexagons for the bookmark.
4. Add the cut out hive to the bookmark.
5. Add the Curry hexagons to the hive.
6. Add the greeting at the top in StazOn ink.
7. Stamp the bee in Black StazOn and cut it out with the Backyard Framelits.
8. Color the bee in with Crushed Curry and Basic Black markers.
9. Add Glitter to the wings with the 2Way glue pen.
10. Cut 5 1/2" of Natural Trim and pull it through the opening of the bookmark. Trim the ends.
11. Tie Early Espresso Bakers Twine around the ribbon.
12. Mount the complete bookmark onto the Chocolate Chip layer.
